- A. 3,000 lbs and Under

- F. 7,001 – 8,000 lbs
- G. 8,001 – 9,000 lbs
- H. 9,001 – 10,000 lbs
- I. 10,001 – 11,000 lbs
- J. 11,001 – 12,000 lbs
- K. 12,001 – 13,000 lbs
- L. 13,001 – 15,000 lbs

Rules for Benton County Tractor Pull:

1. Safety is the first priority. The track judges will be identified at the drivers' meeting prior to the pull. The judges shall disqualify any driver or tractor deemed to be unsafe and will rule on all issues. The judges' decisions shall be final and binding.
2. Any tractor may qualify in a maximum of two (2) classes. One hook per class, except a 4-wheel drive may pay an additional fee and pull a second time in a class as a demonstration pull (no award).
3. Starting positions in each class will be determined by order of weigh-in.
4. Drawbars must not exceed 21" in height. Weights will not be more than 21" forward from the fixed front of the tractor and shall be securely fastened to the tractor. Any weight or part falling off the tractor during the pull shall result in disqualification.
5. The tractor weight will include the driver. There will be no weight or driver changes after the weigh-in.
6. Driver will be 14 years or older and have a valid tractor safety operator's permit.
7. Tractors must have a stock engine, frames, transmission, rear end and axle housing or manufacturer's replacement. Driver must be able to kill engine in an emergency. Functional brakes are required.
8. Tractors may not exceed 5 mph. Engine speed, (RPM) shall be no greater than 10% above manufacturer's stock specifications or Nebraska Test Rating, whichever is greater. Speeds in excess of 5 mph will result in a 25' penalty.
9. There will be no transmission shifting during a pull. A restart will be allowed during the first 25 feet.
10. Pull will end when the flagger signals to stop. Hole digging will result in a 25' penalty.
