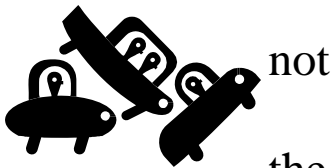


Guidelines for a Safe, Fun Event at the Benton County Fairgrounds

The Fairgrounds is a busy place often with many events going on at the same time. To be fair to everyone and for the safety and comfort of all, please follow these guidelines:

Watch out for traffic!

Parking lots and driveways are for cars and trucks not party guests. Drivers at the Fairgrounds all have places to go and may not be paying attention to your guests. The speed limit is 10 mph – please follow it!



Keep Children Safe!

There are many tempting places for children to get into that are not safe – please

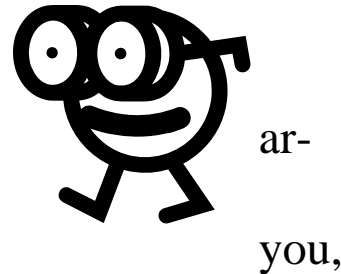
make sure children stay off the marquee sign, away from the horse barns and arena and out of the storage facility. If children want to visit the Batting Cages, make sure they cross through the parking lot safely.



Respect Other Renters!

Remind your party guests to stay in the building you've rented.

Guests wandering into areas, not rented by you, are not appreciated. **Areas strictly off limits include the horse barns & arena, Benton Oaks RV Campground & Shower Building and Oak Grove, all Fairgrounds offices and storage facilities.**



Party noise is the invisible "unwanted guest"!



Please make sure the noise from your party's music is not disturbing our neighbors, other renters or our campers at the Benton Oaks RV Campground by making sure the volume and bass levels are kept at levels that cannot be heard or *felt* outside within 50' of your rental building. **All music must end by midnight.**

Protect Your Guests and Yourself!

If you are serving alcohol, **YOU** are responsible for monitoring your guests. Follow Oregon law by making sure no one under age 21 drinks alcohol and no guest is allowed to leave the party and drive who is not sober. Hiring OLCC licensed servers is the best way to protect everyone.
