

WELCOME to Benton Oaks RV & Campground!

The camp host will ensure an enjoyable stay for all by enforcing the following rules:

Rates: Fees are payable in advance, or within one hour after you arrive RV: \$30/night.

OSU Home games: \$80/weekend for the two night minimum.

Overflow (power & water only) with access to the dump station prior to leaving: \$25/night. Overflow for OSU Home game weekends are \$65/weekend.

Weekly rate is \$180.

Monthly rate is \$450. Monthly spaces are limited each term. Extended stay guests are limited to a six-month duration and two occupants.

Tent - \$20/night/tent of 4 or less. Tent camping is limited to Memorial Day through Labor Day with a five night maximum.

Pets must be kept on a leash or inside a vehicle. Do not leave your pet unattended at your camp space. Do not leave your pets unattended either inside or outside your vehicle. A pet walking area is located at the north fence. Campers are responsible for removal and disposal of pet waste. Do not let your pets make noise at night or become a nuisance to others.

One towed or towing vehicle is allowed per site. All vehicles must be fully operational. The fee for extra vehicles is \$5.00 per night. Vehicles must fit into the campsite or be parked in the overflow parking area to the south of the campground. Mechanical work on vehicles is not allowed.

Restrooms and showers are for use by paying campers only the Camp Host will give you the code for entering. Non-guests pay \$5 per shower. Let us know if these facilities need service. Please do not wash clothes or dishes in the restrooms. Gray water receptacles are located in the camping area.

Laundry Facilities are for paying campers only; the Camp Host will give you the code for entering. Washing pet bedding, blankets and equipment is not allowed.

Please Protect the Oaks. Vehicles must stay out from under oak trees out to the drip line of the branches, except on roadways. The root system of these trees is fragile and is damaged by the weight of vehicles.

Please keep your camp clean and free of debris and clutter. Tarps are not allowed as tents or covers. Please use the trash receptacles provided. Mechanical work on vehicles is not allowed. Current license plates must be maintained on your RV. Your motor home must be fully functional and able to be moved if necessary. Proper Sewer connection must be maintained or a tank attached and dumped regularly (if in Overflow). Monthly campers, please take your garbage to the dumpster behind the auditorium. Commingled recycling is also located by the dumpster. Plastics with the recycling triangle, news and office paper, tin and aluminum are all acceptable. Glass is NOT acceptable in the Commingled recycling.

No fires are allowed at any time. Charcoal grills are allowed

Activities occasionally occur on the Fairgrounds that may interfere or conflict with camping. These activities are part of the value of your stay with us. Please be aware of these activities, as we do not refund camp fees if you later decide that your visit is being disturbed.

Privacy and quiet, aside from the normal Fairgrounds noise, is important. Please respect other campers. Quiet time is 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

Dump Station is for paying guests. The fee for non-guests is \$5.00 per dump.

Check out time is 12:00 noon unless arrangements are made with the camp host. If you plan to stay longer please tell the camp host in person or by phone.
